ORDER

The complainant alleged a superior court judge improperly denied his request to represent himself and a superior court commissioner slandered his character by failing to believe a statement he made in court.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judicial officers engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant, along with the electronic court record, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judicial officers did not violate the Code in this case. The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of court rulings. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
