**ORDER**

The complainant alleged a superior court judge refused to follow the recommendations made in a presentence report knowing the complainant was being maliciously prosecuted.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant and the sentencing minute entry order in the case, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of court rulings. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

Judge failed to sign the report because

prosecuted. Judges hold crucial position which  
require the highest level of integrity. Judge  
has failed this case. On the advice of  
my attorney I am filing this new complaint  
asking that Judge be removed immediately  
from the bench as a superior court judge.
