**ORDER**

The complainant alleged a superior court judge was biased and should have disqualified himself.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

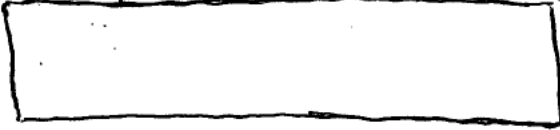
on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013, Judge issued an order

on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013, the Complainant filed on Rule 10.1  
through Rule 10.2 motion for change of Judge, filed by  
the clerk of Superior Court on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013, and assigned  
to Judge in Division 27. (see  
attachment "B" which is the "motion for change of Judge"  
the impropriety of Judge, to  
refuse to promptly transfer Complainant motion to the  
Presiding Judge for consideration, fail to hold timely  
status conference and just hold on to Complainant's  
motion without a fair and impartial hearing that does  
violates Complainant's Constitutional Rights to Due  
Process and Equal Protection of the Law, is conduct  
that reflects adversely upon the Judge's impartiality  
and interfere with the proper performance of his  
duties, violates the canons of the Code of Judicial  
conduct and the Judge should be discipline by this  
Commission.

The Complainant's trial date is set to commence
