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**ORDER**

The complainant alleged that a pro tem justice of the peace erred in approving an arrest warrant, set an unreasonable amount of bail, and violated his due process rights.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission concluded the complaint should be dismissed on the basis that it is stale under Commission Administrative Policy 4 (Investigation of Old Complaints) and essentially repeats the same complaint made and dismissed in 2008, and on the basis that, even if considered at this time, the commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of court rulings or other alleged legal errors. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

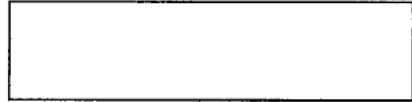
