ORDER

The complainant alleged a justice of the peace was rude, abusive, and violated his rights.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

Judge

It is with great difficulty, and the belief I have managed to escape the abuse, disrespect and deliberate abuses of power and disregard of my most basic rights. I realize that some of what I am describing will seem somewhat unbelievable, so I will respectfully ask you to examine the actual court record, the tapes of the court hearing as proof of what I am saying and why I am requesting help.

I have appeared before judges
the court in Arizona. These are some
of the case numbers that relate to my complaint

I believe there is an additional two (2) or three (3) case number that relate to this complaint that I do not have access to because I am in jail.

This complaint is not meant to be a defendant unhappy with a sentence, this is a complaint about someone wanting to accept responsibility but at the same time wanting a fair trial, the credit for time served as a result of time spent in jail for misconduct to be allowed to respectfully address the court and be heard.

I am the defendant and as such I have a right to due process, to be treated with respect, dignity and to be free from harassment abuses and intimidation throughout my proceeding.

Judge has called me an easy arrest told me I was worthless, refused to give me credit for time served. Am scheduled for court in the morning he makes me wait till then tells me its too late come back tomorrow I have served sentence but he wont apply the time towards the fine. The judge intimidates by calling me names and being disrespectful.

This is further complicated because the judge does this prior to hearing my case, passing judgement on me, making it very clear that he has already formed an opinion of me, when a judge tells you, you are stupid that he doesnt like you and sets

Court hearing all on different day to purposely cause you to miss work there is a problem. I came to the court with an outstanding warrant I tried to turn myself in the judge saw me on the case I was in front of him for but refused to see me on the warrant saying let him get arrested. My post bail for me using her.

as security the judge refuses to return the title I arrange for a hearing to exonerate the bail. The clerk says its ok you do need to be here, then the

Judges don't return the title to my. It's very clear that the judge is frustrated with me. I am sorry that in my youth I may have been a difficult young man. However I am not that same young man I don't do drugs, I follow instructions. If you put me in jail for not paying a fine and don't give me credit for the time served then I'm imprisoned for a debt I can never pay and it becomes a revolving door I realize that how the judge disposes of fines is his discretion however if the sole purpose of my confinement is that issue I should receive credit for time served. It is not the judge's job to teach me a lesson it's to dispense justice. I can't, and nor would I, call the judge out of his name but yet he calls me out of mine. To receive due process to have a fair trial it has to start with a judge who does not have predisposed opinions. I have asked the judge to recuse himself and I can't even get the previous motion heard. I am not asking for a particular judge, I'm only asking for a fair one. There is clearly justifiable distrust as a result as to how the judge has treated me. When a judge says he going to get you, then it's

its no longer a judicial process it become
 vendictiveness. I am formally asking you conduct
 an investigation of the judicial misconduct,
 the judge's actions have denied me substantial
 procedure rights, including the right to a fair and
 impartial presentation of the case, the right to
 due process, equal protection, a fair trial and
 appeal, freedom from double jeopardy, and freedom
 from cruel and unusual punishment under the fourth
 fifth, sixth, eighth and fourteenth amendment of
 the United States Constitution and Under Article 2
 Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 10, 11, 15, 24, 32 and 33.

Taken together for the foregoing reasons please
 conduct an investigation into these issues. I
 have become the victim.
