ORDER

The complainant alleged a superior court judge had blocked his access to proper justice.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the judge's rulings. In addition, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

Matter of the great concern:

I was scheduled for the Trail on _____ at the _____ Court to argue and show cause for my case as a Plaintiff .

Two to Three hours before the beginning of my Trial, mysteriously in the darkness of early morning on that _____ I missed my steps and vertically crashed down three feet to hard concrete ground. This unfortunate accident cause tremendous pain, severe enough that I could not get up to my feet without the assistance of my daughter who arrived to my location approximately one hour later. Time is now about _____ At this time my Court Trail is set to begin only _____ hours later. So I could not seek or even didn't think about seeking Medical attention, so I took several unknown Pain Killer that was available to me from the families left over proscriptions.

As my only choice on or about _____ I made a telephone call to the Courts _____ reporting this incident and my painful conditions. The Clerk of the Court advised me that I should present myself at the Court and allow the Judge to decide whether the Trail should be set for continuance.

I followed the instruction and went and presented myself at the Court, being only a few minutes late. Upon my arrival the Trail started. At this time I am in pain and under the influence of the medication. This entire Trial has escaped me as it was something like a nightmare that I woke up from. At this Trail I was in so much pain that even the Judge stated " It is obvious that you are under tremendous pain and I don't want to see you passing out on the Court's floor" she said and this is on record. Then she said "I have to rap things up".

The Judge was right. I was under tremendous amount of pain I also was effected by the pain killers that I took earlier that morning. I in fact did not belong to that Court room, I should have been in the Emergency Room where I went the very next available time.

To the best of my understanding this trial ended at [redacted] in the afternoon the Honorable Judge did not enter to any judgment at the end of this Trial and my medical condition was bad when I arrived to the court and it only got worse as the Trial continued. After the Trial ended it took me nearly [redacted] to get on my feet and exit the Courtroom. I made it to the parking lot an [redacted] later but I could not drive away until almost [redacted] This day was nothing but one of the worst nightmare that I went through.

On the very next day [redacted] my daughter took me to Emergency Room where I was given [redacted] shot and prescribed [redacted] After the Emergency Room visit I was advised to continue with my Family Doctor for farther examination and additional treatment. I do not remember any of these happening to me with the alignment of any time or calender, all I member that these events occurred, almost like a dream.

I remember that one morning I woke up and noticed the date. It is [redacted] This day is significant because any other days between [redacted] and [redacted] did not consciously mean any thing to me and I was unaware of my situation and decisions that I was making. As to [redacted] there was no judgment issued Nor I was aware of the possibility of what the judgment can be, what I knew that at the Trail I was desperately trying to keep the ground below my feet and stop the ceilings from spinning over my head and Judge knew this and statement she made to this fact is on the record.

I on the [redacted] immediately filed a motion requesting for a new Fair Trail and with this motion I supplemented proper doctors report. This motion has been denied and my every other attempt to get the proper Justice has been blocked. I am deeply concerned about this Justice and my rights has been violated at the floor of this Court where I went to seek Justice. Please help me so I can have my fair day at the Court.
