ORDER

A justice of the peace is alleged to have failed to disqualify himself due to a conflict of interest.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. After learning of the ethics complaint, the judge recused himself and transferred the case. The commission approved sending the judge a private advisory letter to remind him that he is not required to recuse himself merely because an ethics complaint has been filed. The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23(a).
