ORDER

The complainant alleged a pro tem superior court judge coerced him to sign a deed and failed to provide him accommodations for his disability.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. The commission approved sending the judge an advisory letter encouraging him to familiarize himself with Rule 92, Arizona Rules of Family Law Procedure, regarding contempt proceedings and civil contempt law in general. The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23(a).
