#### ORDER

The complainant alleged a justice of the peace abused the prestige of judicial office and failed to promote confidence in the judiciary.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After review, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. The commission approved sending the judge a warning letter urging him to take proposed court policies up with the other judges in his consolidated court. If they are approved by a majority of the judges, they can then be distributed for comment externally or otherwise implemented by the court. The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23(a).
