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**ORDER**

The complainant alleged a superior court judge had improperly allowed a municipality to sue him.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the judge's rulings. In addition, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

The Arizona Constitution, Ari-  
zona Revised Statutes, and  
City Charter stipulate that prior  
to beginning the duties of  
office the individual shall take  
a subscribed oath of office and  
shall receive no compensation  
until the subscribed oath is  
taken.

Title 13 of the Arizona Revised  
Statutes states that when a  
property owner directs an  
individual to leave that property

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and never return and should  
the individual to return to the  
the individual is guilty  
of criminal trespass.
