ORDER

The complainant alleged a superior court judge improperly dismissed an order of protection.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the judicial officer's rulings. In addition, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

During the hearing regarding an appeal for a Order of protection in court room, Judge Denied a Order of protection stating that the verbal abuse, intimidation, threats, foul language, trespassing, repeated hurtful exchange, disregard, name calling and in front of my was not considered Domestic Violence or trespassing. After sworn testimony & witness, Judge stated the above does not meet to enforce an order of protection. These behaviors are all forms of The anger, tone, and intimidation does impact my family. This has happened before in other court proceedings where I was unknowing of the law and did not & could not afford representation. I am requesting that the bias, prejudice, and unfair treatment & rulings needs to be assessed. Please let me know what documents you need or witness contact numbers to further investigate this matter. I provided police reports, testimony, witness & the alleged lied & was believed

Also allowed to change testimony, add to testimony further demonstrating were lies. The judge has allowed past testimony without replying, no payment to reply or court fees on the other party + still allowed testimony, judgement + rulings. The safety of myself has crossed the level. Judge is known for being biased towards women in County. I only have left in his rulings. I am fearful of the retaliation but need someone else to know. I do not feel I am the only one that has been treated this way. I believe in the system and have tried to protect myself + children.
