ORDER

The complainants alleged a municipal court judge improperly granted an injunction against harassment and deprived one of the complainants of her firearms.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the judicial officer's rulings. In addition, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

Thank you for taking the time to read my complaint against

I am _____, who has granted me written, notarized consent to represent her in all matters concerning _____ whose _____, went to _____ to file an Injunction Against Harassment against my daughter and to have her two guns illegally seized by four _____ and _____ police officers after _____ had dropped out of the university forced by the relentless psychological lynching perpetrated on her by three _____ armer who enjoyed persecuting my adult child since she first set foot in the aforementioned college by fabricating or completely distorting events and conversations. I wonder: do these men delight in treating students cruelly simply because they like feeling powerful, or because they have to justify their salaries? I guess I will never know.

Why did I state in the previous paragraph that my daughter's guns were, "illegally seized"? Because it was so. None of the false accusations by _____ merited the confiscation of _____ firearms, as you will be able to confirm by reading the Injunction Against Harassment, which I have enclosed.

_____ filed the Injunction Against Harassment because my daughter went to her house ONCE and ONLY ONCE (and once does not constitute harassment) in search of _____ protection against her lynchers and to let the president know that Muslim students were allowed to cheat on exams out of respect for their culture; that the cafeteria food was so bad, that she _____ had to drop out of the meal plan; and that her statistics instructor had humiliated and slandered her in the presence of all her classmates after she informed the dean that the instructor had announced to the whole classroom that sometimes she allows students to cheat on tests because she feels sorry for them. _____ was coerced to take another statistics class, in which the administration did not allow her to stay out of spite.

Yes, my daughter is the child in the crowd that yells, "The emperor is naked." , on the other hand, is made up of deceiving tailors and intimidated subjects. I went to house in a desperate attempt to obtain help and to denounce corruption and because she had not been allowed to have a private conversation with in the university.

When sought assistance by visiting her unannounced, answered the door and was surprised when told her that she was an student who needed her aid; however, was far from scared, as some want to claim; her husband was home, so she asked him to hand her the planner and gave , who was unarmed as she was always unarmed when at the university, an appointment for Monday next in the afternoon. , who never entered house, left immediately after getting the appointment and after, of course, thanking ; that Friday evening, when my daughter cried desperately for help.

was filled with hope; she would finally have a chance to speak face to face with the president, but her hopes were dashed by and , who told upon her entering office, that she would be meeting with them instead. Besides this, a woman who was supposed to be one of office administrators attempted to snatch away backpack but did not succeed; my daughter was told later that the aforementioned woman was an undercover police officer; in other words, : had been treated like a potential criminal. (whom had never seen because all communication had always been carried out through the computer) proceeded to interrogate and accuse my daughter falsely, so she left while displaying her justified anger with colorful words she uttered in her naturally loud voice.

Three days later, on dropped out of with no desire to ever set foot in such a horribly corrupt institution; but this was not enough for . By the way, the latter has never seen. I called my husband at work (after having an police officer get the number from me through deceit) on to tell him that if did not sign a paper accepting she was guilty of all their slanderous charges, they () would file Injunctions Against Harassment against , who, of course, did not sign, for she was simply being persecuted for denouncing corruption and injustice and for refusing to fill out an unconstitutional survey. The three men did file the injunctions after my daughter had left , but the dismissed them on did not dismiss Injunction Against Harassment because it never appeared publicly anywhere, while the other three injunctions did and do appear on Arizona's Public Access after having been served illegally at my home, for they were left by the server between our screen and front doors while my husband was napping and was the only person in the house.

The illegal seizure of my daughter's two guns took place the morning of Saturday, after my daughter had dropped out of because no one would help her or be fair to her. was relaxing in her apartment when she heard a knock on the door. She got a hold of one of her guns very quickly because she thought the unexpected visitor might be the stalker that had been bothering her for some time to the point that she had to call the opened the door and put the firearm behind her back when she realized that the law was the one paying her a visit. One of the deputies asked her if she was hiding a gun behind her back; answered affirmatively; the deputy asked her to put the gun away, and she did. Next, the four deputies from and the two officers (all males) surrounded my daughter; showed her the papers prepared by ; and told her that if she did not surrender her two guns immediately, she would be arrested because the papers were a Court order. My daughter complied; and, as soon as the six officers left her apartment, she called my husband and me to relate to us the unjust, unpleasant incident. My husband and I felt shocked and indignant at the flagrant abuse of authority perpetrated by ; but we were also relieved by the fact that we were already on our way to pick up our daughter and bring her home. is a brave, strong young woman; someone else may not have survived so much lynching, slandering, and persecution.

Please remember, Your Honor: My daughter was not armed when she visited injured anyone, for she is a decent, studious woman.
