The Code of Judicial Conduct provides that a successful judicial candidate is subject to discipline under the code for violation of any rules set forth in Canon 4 (Political or Campaign Activity), even if the candidate was not a judge during the period of candidacy. The complaint in this matter was against a judicial candidate who was not successful in his bid for office, and therefore, the commission has no jurisdiction in this matter. This file is now closed.
