ORDER

The complainant alleged a justice of the peace was biased against her as a self-represented litigant and did not rule in a timely fashion. The complainant also alleged a second justice of the peace had not ruled in a timely fashion and was retaliating against her for her complaint against the first justice of the peace.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judges engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of either judge's rulings. In addition, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the second judge did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed as to the second judge, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

After further review, the commission also found no evidence of ethical misconduct as to the first judge, and concluded that the first judge did not violate the Code in this case. The commission approved sending the first judge an advisory letter reminding him to review files thoroughly prior to the entry of judgment to ensure compliance with Rule 2.5 of the Code (Competence, Diligence, and Cooperation). The complaint is dismissed as to the first judge pursuant to Rules 16(b) and 23(a).

This order may not be used as a basis for disqualification of a judge.

Commission members Peter J. Eckerstrom and Art Hinshaw did not participate in the consideration of this matter.
