ORDER

The Complainant alleged a pro tem municipal court judge improperly issued a protective order against her.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Diane M. Johnsen and Christopher P. Staring did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

ON JUDGE ALLOWED THE PLAINTIFF TO PRESENT EVIDENCE THAT WAS AGAINST THE PLAINTIFF AND NOT AGAINST ME, A POLICE REPORT IN WHICH I WAS LISTED AS A VICTIM, AND THE PLAINTIFF AS A SUSPECT, ANOTHER POLICE REPORT WAS A MEDIATION TO RESOLVE OF THE HARASSMENT OF MY NEIGHBOR, THE JUDGE NOT EVEN READ THE POLICE REPORTS, SHE GRANTED AN INJECTION AGAINST HARASSMENT AGAINST MYSELF, SINCE THAN THE PLAINTIFF AND HER HUSBAND HAVE BEEN MAKING THREATS AGAINST ME, HER HUSBAND SAID HE AND OTHER MEN THAT LIVE AT THE PLAINTIFF'S RENTAL HOME, SAID THEY WERE GOING TO RAPE ME AND BEAT ME UP, BY THE TIME SOMEONE WOULD FIND ME THEY WOULD BE HALFWAY TO BECAUSE OF THE POLICE DEPT, JUDGE FOLLOWED P.D. ADVICE, AND GRANTED AN INJECTION AGAINST ME, AND NOW I AM PAYING THE PRICE MY LIFE IS IN SERIOUS DANGER,
