ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge improperly ordered her home to be destroyed.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Denise K. Aguilar and George H. Foster, Jr. did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

I was renting out my back yard to _____ who at the time informed me that she was going to place a shed in my back yard. _____ was evicted for non payment and the shed was left in the backyard and _____ the company took me to court and stated I was responsible for paying the shed even though they already had a judgment for _____ for the shed. I informed them that I wasn't going to pay them a damn dime because I never purchased a shed from them. I never knew the shed was there's, I never gave them permission to place the shed on my property and now Judge _____ has granted them permission to destroy my home. I do not understand how any court has the right to order that someone's home be destroyed. The company informed me that they would give me \$_____ if I gave them permission to destroy my home and I informed them '_____. I those 2 brick walls attached to my home are knocked down my home will be damaged and left unsecured. I will go to jail before I allow anyone to take a bulldozer to my home. The company has a judgment against _____ for the full amount and now they have obtained an additional judgement against me for the full amount and Judge _____ has granted them permission to destroy my home so that they can dig out the shed from my back yard. I am elderly and disabled and do not have money to obtain an attorney. I believe that this judge has allowed this big company and high priced attorney to obtain _____ times what that shed is worth (\$ _____) because I am elderly and disabled.
