ORDER

October 2, 2019

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge had a “personal vendetta” against him and failed to consider mitigating factors in his criminal case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer’s legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

I am writing on behalf of my partner and fiancé who's is currently in the custody of the

I am wiring you now to inform you of some missing information the probation office failed to account for in the decision to revoke his probation. had his probation transferred from the County Parole and Probation Department to the County Probation Department under the responsibility of Officer However, under her charge was transferred to a satellite office where the abilities of her position where severely compromised. She had no outgoing long distance calling, this severe lack of resources essentially made her neglectful of her charges. called her daily for with no response back. (We can provide phone records, at his honors request) Her immediate supervisor was aware of this incapacity of her position, and when requesting support and advice, her response was ". This lack of professionalism seriously brings to question the credibility of her position and the entire County Probation Office.

With permission secured employment in and (We can provide pay statements, at his honors request), while residing with his mother in Arizona. Once this employment was unfortunately ended he sought new employment elsewhere. He notified by phone, leaving multiple voicemails, with no response back. interviewed in which employment was allowed. Once the position was secured, we were going to transfer his probation back to

We feel that the failure of duty by the County Probation office, as well as the County public defender's office for failing to investigate all defenses warrants his reinstatement of probation with consideration for his time served, and the deferment of any transfer fees associated with the transfer of his probation upon release from the Department of Corrections. We are also requesting an investigation into the County Probation office's negligence, so these events can be prevented in the future from happening to anyone else.

The events of the arrest on being found that no crime was committed is further proof was not given a fair opportunity in his rehabilitation efforts.
