ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court commissioner colluded with the State and denied his constitutional rights.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Colleen E. Concannon did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

If sometimes sounds angry in his videos and his words, he has reason to be. In fact, it is impressive how he manages to keep things together and maintain good humour. This is the story of a veteran who believes he experienced over 100 violations of his rights.

As a reporter, it certainly seems he has reason to feel this way, even though the organisations in question are hardly coming forward to explain or to help. The story is complex, it involves several US institutions, none of which seem to be able to fully explain their dealings with him in the past, or why they are failing to meet his needs and his rights now.

Here are some of the issues he's had; all agencies I have contacted have shut down communications with me- perhaps some more dogged reporter with better on-the-ground resources can help make a difference not just to him but to the tens of thousands who are in similar unacceptable situations.
