ORDER

May 12, 2020

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge prejudged her case and did not afford her the same opportunity to be heard as the opposing party. The complainant also alleged a second superior court judge unfairly sanctioned her and flipped a coin to make a decision.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Roger D. Barton and Michael J. Brown did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Dear Commission of Judicial Conduct Representative:

She had to tell him more than once that he was not privileged to any information discussed between myself and her. I was excited about the future and the ability this purchase might give me, one day, to buy more property that I could fix, flip and sell it. At the time of my purchase, asked me not to add to the property and demanded I not leave it to her upon my death. He did not want to fight with for his right to the property when I died. As I look back, I realize, he knew exactly what he was doing. He already had put his plan into action. Together we sought, the advice of counsel and paralegal, " "
