Disposition of Complaint 20-068

ORDER

June 18, 2020

The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace improperly fined him and suspended his license in a civil traffic matter.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Denise K. Aguilar did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Judge Complaint

When this took place I sent the judge paperwork that showed him the [redacted] Businesses what were stolen from me. and I described to him that [redacted] Cartel people that had pistoles at my head saying I would be killed if I did not cross the Border because The thief known as [redacted] did not want to be taken to court. I told the Presidents of [redacted] office secretary [redacted] that if I went to court [redacted] and the Cartel people said they would kill me. I told [redacted] this and she was paid not to protect me. Even the Military chief in [redacted] who was a friend when I was driving the Fiesta Cruiser with over [redacted] people said he did not want to be seen talking with me. When the Judge [redacted] made [redacted] pages of paperwork about the vehicles [redacted] and the Cartel people were stealing. The [redacted] said he did not want to take the paperwork from the Judge. The judge in [redacted] was paid [redacted] of dollars not to protect me even though I had paid him. Now after [redacted] stole everything money and businesses and everything he had [redacted] of dollars to pay even the [redacted] government. Now with having 2 pistols at my head at the border I have had surgery on my eye. I had to sell the spare tite to have the gas to cross the border. This ticket to be processed against me like this is unbelievable the Judge said If I paid [redacted] now and I did he would give me permission to drive a car. The DMV says because I am so bad I now have to pay

insurance for 5 years. Paying for insurance for my daughter to drive has cost over 1000 a month instead of the 200 a month insurance for me as I was quoted so now for 5 years after I have had to pay over 1000 for the past 5 years for insurance .because of this. Everybody including the policeman behind the office glass window in Mexico said we will kill you and your family now and do it legally. Then he got up from the window and walked away. When I was in Mexico I was a respected business man by the Cartel people enough that they would call me over 100 miles to convince the people that saw them to forget what they saw to be allowed to live. It worked and I was proud to do it. When I was In the USA I managed to cure the disease 10 years ago see 10 Now I have solved high blood pressure problem 10 and even the drug people have told me my cure is so cheap they would not promote not selling the expensive bad blood pressure drugs. This seems to be a different world than I was born in. I am having one hell of time economically supporting my family. I have been told by 10 people in Arizona you should have allowed them to kill you crossing the border Now you are going to feel so bad you are going to wish they would have killed you.
