ORDER

The complainant alleged a superior court judge had a conflict of interest in handling a protective order proceeding.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

After review, the Commission found the judge failed to disclose a potential basis for disqualification on the record. While this was improper under Rule 2.11 of the Code of Judicial Conduct, the Scope Section of the Code provides that not every transgression will result in the imposition of discipline. The Commission decided, after considering all the facts and circumstances, to dismiss the Complaint pursuant to Commission Rules 16(b) and 23(a), but to issue a warning letter to the judicial officer reminding him of his full obligations regarding disqualification under Rule 2.11.

Commission members Roger D. Barton and Joseph C. Kreamer did not participate in the consideration of this matter.


