The Complainant alleged that a justice of the peace was not impartial and incorrectly ruled on a petition for order of protection.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member J. Tyrrell Taber did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

During an Order of Protection (OOP) hearing, the plaintiff, claimed the respondent. hit him and he feared for his life. During the hearing, girlfriend, took the stand as a witness. She stated she saw but did NOT say he struck SWING at (Judge did not ask for clarification as to whether or not she saw make contact with). She also mentioned was carrying a large bag of dog food on his shoulder (the side from allegedly struck him). was on porch steps and was standing in the carport, making it which essentially impossible for to make contact with did not ask for clarification Again, Judge (would it have been possible for contact to be made?)

Had Judge been impartial, he would have asked for clarification regarding whether the witness saw make contact with and if it would have been possible for to make contact since was carrying a large bag on his shoulder. I also believe Judge should have been suspicious when threw a hissy fit in the Courtroom after his father announced his decision.

I bring this up now because another case is before Judge and I fear he will, again, not be impartial. It is my belief that Judge makes decisions as if he were still a prosecuting attorney (focused on conviction) and not an impartial judge. I know this case is not an anomaly because I've heard similar stories from others, including attorneys. This was not a situation of being a ' '. This was a case of the judge not being impartial.

I understand you cannot change the outcome of this case, and I am not looking for a change in the decision. I am trying to prevent someone else from having a similar experience.
