ORDER

October 22, 2021

The Complainant alleged that a superior court judge exhibited bias and violated the law when he did not transfer a change of judge request to the presiding judge.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Christopher W. Ames did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Rule AD-6 Change of Judge

Any "Notice of Change of Judge" shall be filed with the Clerk of the Court and copies served on all parties, the Court Administrator, the Presiding Judge, and the Presiding Judge of the Division of the Court (e.g., Civil, Criminal, Juvenile). Upon timely request for a change of Judge, the case shall be transferred to the Presiding Judge or designee for reassignment if appropriate - effective

Of the counties comprising Arizona, only others provide for a local rule addressing a change of judge: (Rule 2.7) and (Rule 1.9).

Around I filed for a change of Judge for Cause, pursuant to 10.1. Judge improperly asserted " and refused my lawful motion - without first transferring it to the Presiding Judge.

Judge has a proven track record of extreme bias towards me (based on my Gender-Identity) He has employed numerous procedures which are both unauthorized and

It has become painfully clear to Judge that I intend to expose his unlawful conduct. To dismiss my 10.1, contrary to local rule AD-6 was his last " to salvage both his professional career as a Jurist and his liberty as a citizen.

Judicial ethics are governed by Rule 81 of the Arizona Court.
