The Complainant alleged that a superior court commissioner tampered with the record, failed to give her notice of a ruling, and used an insulting name for her minor child.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Barbara Brown and Christopher P. Staring did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Furthermore, after I filed a Notice re: Petitioner's Default on Family Support, Transfer of Community Assets and Others in I just found that she entered an order called " dated but never notifies me in any manner, and I have no any information regarding what the order is for Instead, the opposing party, following this order, filed documents on and Apparently, he has the knowledge of the order. It directly affects my right for a timely appeal, and it is unlawful conduct on a continuous basis. Manipulation of public records is also criminal acts, and Commissioner and her Division should be sent to state and federal investigation for criminal convictions.

Also, Commissioner called the minor " when the minor is in fact a She declared jurisdiction when she wants the authority to order.
