ORDER

The Complainant alleged that a superior court judge made incorrect rulings, and violated his right to represent himself.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Barbara Brown did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

My name is _____ and From _____ to _____ I attend the _____ psychiatric care system on a volunatiry basis and was discharged without any of the 3 doctors I spoke with in person mandating a full mental evaluation. _____ I was picked up while naked under a towel in the middle of a night based on a petition filed by my parents and brother who I am having major business disputes with. Many issues with the system in general, but specifically for _____ I will explain how my rights were violated, proven to be violated and then trampled on which lead to forced medication which is something I expressed deep religious concerns over. I DID NOT WANT MEDICATION. Now the injustice is real but luckily the damages were limited because before the courts ruling I was being prescribed anti psycotics, but by time I was court ordered my doctor did not feel that would be necessary and placed on mood stabilizers which are known to cause no effects on my ability to comprehend or represent myself. Now at court We started the trial off with me requesting to self represent but keep my lawyer on as an advisor. The judge agreed to do this while holding the right to take away my self representation and give it back to my lawyer if he saw that I was incapable of defending myself. Next he states that there will be only 20 mintues for each side to make their case and 20 mintues for witness questioning. Well, I objected with a statement saying you can get a fair trial if questions are left unasked because time was limited, so object to the idea this is fair or reasonable. He seemed agitated and basically took my objection on the record and we moved on. Then the county prosecutor moves to submit 3 doctor affidavits. I objected again, but this time with a motion to supress such documents. The Judge asked why I deserved the files to be supressed, as I responded something like. " the Documents of the petition were served to me on the same day I received the sworn statments from my doctors and inside the petition paperwork it states it is my right to choose my evaluting physicians. Because I received both at the same time and because the 1st page was the officers sworn serving noticing with matching officer names, times and dates, giving imperial proof that my rights were violated and that all documents arrising out of that vioation should have been supressed.
