ORDER

The Complainant alleged that a justice of the peace had a conflict of interest in hearing her matter, was partial in favor of the opposing party, and denied her right to be heard.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Christopher W. Ames did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Upon Justice _____ entering the courtroom, she waved and smiled at the family followed with a wink. When I approached the bench, I began to say that I had planned to leave on the _____ of the month due to title 15a...Justice _____ said that rule didn't exist and that I should have consulted an attorney. _____ and _____ then asked how to fill certain court documents out, specifically court fees because they would have had to log any arrears beforehand. _____ specifically stated he did not want any monies AND that no monies were owed, but _____ overruled him and Justice _____ helped.

HAD I BEEN ALLOWED TO DEFEND MYSELF, I WOULD HAVE POINTED OUT THE FOLLOWING:

- 1.) I would like to have spoken about the police report I finally received but Justice _____ made sure I had no additional oppertunity to speak.
- 2.) I also would have mentioned that my father should not have been included in the eviction, as he had nothing to do with the eviction action. The action was solely due to my break-up with their son. My rights were violated to force eviction 5 days before I had already planned to leave, and putting my families rental record in jeopardy.
- 3.) They have helped their son obviscate justice, when the Post Master General caught him smoking marijuana at the post office. They are practiced at this, as they also obviscated justice for their meth addicted daughter who committed crimes, but they talked people out of filing charges. Justice _____ is part of this conspiracy to obviscate justice and side with the _____ no matter what.
- 4.) I should mention I met Justice _____ years earlier at _____ home in _____, so I know they run in the same circles.
