ORDER

The Complainant alleged that a superior court judge denied him “fairness and safety,” refused to hear his allegation of sexual assault and domestic violence, and refused to address statements made by the opposing party’s counsel.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Delia R. Neal did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Regarding safety _____ has basically held open the door of safety and allowed Petitioner and her cohorts including Petitioner's _____ to continually abuse me thus condoning the actions by taking no action. I have filed an objection on _____ in the case regarding this and have yet to receive a response.

_____ has made statements dismissing my claims of sexual assault and domestic violence from Petitioner, a matter that she has refused to hear. _____ statement bypass due process, passing judgement on open _____ investigations such as _____ and _____ without a trial. _____ statement disregards the documented recommendation for _____ assault charges as well as claims of sexual assault, harassment, and death threats painted on Respondent's vehicle and passes judgement without due process.

Respondent contends that he will not receive a fair trial due to _____ actions. On _____ Judge _____ instructed Respondent that she will do nothing without proof and said proof had to be presented to another judge. By not allowing Respondent to submit evidence, _____ has greatly impaired Respondent's right to a fair trial.

Further, _____ inaction regarding Respondent's multiple pleas for help has not only contributed to an ongoing abusive environment, it condones it. _____ is already aware of Petitioner's email on _____ to _____ Judge _____ stating that Respondent was "bat crazy", a completely derogatory and unnecessary comment as it relates to Respondent's diagnosis. Judge _____ was the bankruptcy judge for Petitioner and the email was sent by mere days before the hearing and was ignored by that Judge as well! Even after being presented with this information and Respondent's request for assistance, _____ took no action to admonish such derogatory statements in this Court as related to Respondent's disability. Petitioner's _____ making inappropriate statements is not isolated. _____ dated _____ to Respondent's former Counsel, Petitioner's Counsel refers to Respondent as "certifiable" and putting on a "performance" over a triggered PTSD response that one could argue he triggered. _____ has allowed the hostile behaviors time and again.
