ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court commissioner was rude, insulting, and unprofessional during a hearing.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Colleen E. Concannon did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

The short time he was on the medications /treatment seemed promising. That was short lived and he refuses treatment to this day.

At @ age was bullied in school in Arizona. The school ignored what was happening and the bullying was not stopped. In addition was raped and this took its toll. I got him to and he was successfully treated in and subsequently also in He was stabilized in both places with minimal medication that being a single medication in both, had made friends and graduated High School. Here in Arizona the care of the mentally ill is radically different than in the rest of America and is the lowest in the country. My son is
