#### **ORDER**

### April 21, 2022

The Complainant alleged a superior court commissioner had improperly continued a case even though the other party was guilty of abandonment and perjury. She also alleged the commissioner improperly ordered her child to be removed from the home. She requested that the pending case be dismissed, her child placed back in her care, and the other party be given a life sentence.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Christopher W. Ames and Louis Frank Dominguez did not participate in the consideration of this matter.
