ORDER

The Complainant alleged a superior court judge failed to report an instance of perjury to a prosecuting agency.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Joseph C. Kreamer and Delia R. Neal did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Moreover, despite showing that I was on disability for a traumatic brain injury, made me pay the brunt of court costs with no regard to my limited income. She knew that my ex-wife made times annually what I did yet she made me foot the bill for services that my ex-wife's attorney recommended.
