The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace allowed inaccurate information about a civil case to appear on a court public information website.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Michael J. Brown did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

In my contact with Court, she verified for me that their internal database and at the case management system shows that you are the named Defendant in this underlying civil case, not the named Plaintiff. As specifically stated on the homepage for the Public Access Case Lookup website, "The information may not be a current, accurate, or complete record of the case" and "the Arizona judiciary does not provide any warranty, express or implied, that the information provided is accurate, current, correct, or complete." There has been no evidence of any kind presented to show that Mr. is responsible for the inaccurate data on this website.

I have determined that further investigation is not warranted at this time and our file has been closed.
