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**ORDER**

September 15, 2023

The complainant alleged a superior court judge (now retired) failed to sign a loyalty oath and unlawfully collected a salary.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a). It is further ordered denying the Complainants' request to appear before the Commission.

Commission member Barbara Brown did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

#### ALLEGATIONS

- 1) Fraud - Ariz. Const. Art. IV § 26. Judge failed to sign the Loyalty Oath of Office prior to assuming office (see attached).
- 2) Breach of contract - id. #1 above & #3 below.
- 3) Judge allegedly was not a Judge at the time of my Settlement conference or Sentencing (Analogy: The Governor would not be Governor if the Loyalty Oath of Office was not administered, inter alia).
- 4) Judge fraudulently received compensation (Salary) from when she finally signed the Loyalty Oath of Office (As obtained by Esq. from the Ofc), allegedly.
- 5) Obstruction of Justice - Violations of the 5th, 6th & 14th Amends. due process clauses, inter alia.

## Requested Remedies

- 6) Case # \_\_\_\_\_ must be at least reviewed and retried.
- 7) All Judge \_\_\_\_\_ cases during the time in question must be reviewed/retried.
- 8) Judge \_\_\_\_\_ must reimburse the state for all compensation received during the time in question including accrued interest.
- 9) id.#8 above, includes retirement funds.
- 10) Judge \_\_\_\_\_ must reimburse me for Pecuniary losses of some \$ \_\_\_\_\_ (Social Security Benefits), Est.  $\uparrow$  1mo. X years.
- 11) The Judicial Commission refers this matter to the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ attorney for possible criminal investigation.
- 12) All \_\_\_\_\_ Court, \_\_\_\_\_ Court and \_\_\_\_\_ Court judges must have their personnel files reviewed for compliance with A2. CONST. ART. ~~6726~~ ART. VI } 26
- 13) Per the Doctrine of Respondent Superior, all supervisory Judges during the time period in question are similarly liable and must be similarly investigated, allegedly.
