The complainant alleged improper legal rulings by a justice of the peace pro tem hearing a criminal case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

I was set up for failure in a conflict of interest case because I was unlawfully arrested while conducting a first amendment audit at the _____ . The first amendment auditing community is commonly discriminated against by law enforcement and the justice system for being civil rights watchdogs and have channels for publishing our unlawful arrests that ultimately embarrasses the city for not understanding or discriminating against the public's first amendment rights.

I was set up for failure because all of my motions were denied. There was missing video evidence. When I was arrested, my camera was taken as evidence but none of the security camera footage was taken or the postmaster's photos he took with his phone. Just goes to show the officer's spite to take my equipment but not collect their evidence too and the judge was OK with that.

I wrote another motion that explained the body camera footage I got in my discovery was blurred and my personal video was edited in violation of best evidence rules and

All of my motions had solid grounds. I wrote more motions but I can't remember what they were And I have no access to them being that I am being held in the _____ County jail for calling the _____ for assistance on pressing charges on All of the witnesses who blatantly perjured in the face of video evidence. Even the appeal judge said the evidence was plain and clear when he dismissed the trespassing charge. The perjury is my biggest complaint. Every last witness lied in order to secure A conviction. I made A video on my channel called _____ that clearly notifies the viewer of every lie that was plain and clear in the face of the video evidence. The title of the video is called "_____". I also feel the judge should have reviewed the large amount of evidence before making his ruling that shamed the public's confidence in the legal system.

Twice I contacted the courts for the name of the Judge and prosecutor. After the first request I was sent a Case Summary Report. The second time I requested clarification of the Judge's and prosecutor's names, but I never heard back. I included with this complaint the Case Summary Report.

I also have a complaint about my rights and procedure to file post conviction relief. I was never given notice by the court. I asked my Appeals Attorney and he told me the deadline to file notice of post conviction relief and that the court would point an attorney to assist me. I filed notice of post conviction relief but I never heard back. I was waiting for contact from a court appointed attorney or further instructions from the court but nothing came. I would still like to pursue the post conviction relief remedy but I'm sure the deadline has expired and sealed the city's liability for their actions.
