#### **ORDER**

# September 8, 2023

The complainant alleged a superior court commissioner issued improper legal rulings in a civil case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Roger D. Barton and Joseph C. Kreamer did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Dear Arizona Commission on Judicial Conduct,						
I am writing to file a formal complaint against Judge and Commissioner as well as their judicial staff, for their biased and prejudiced conduct during my recent court case. I strongly believe that their actions have undermined the integrity of the Arizona Civil Justice System and resulted in a grave miscarriage of justice.						
From the outset of my case, it was evident that Judge was unprepared and ill-equipped to conduct proceedings fairly and impartially. During the hearing on Judge was on a video conference and appeared to be incoherent and disoriented. He stated that he was experiencing and was seen walking around during open arguments, which leads me to believe he may have been under the influence of pain medication. His behavior was unacceptable and not conducive to a fair and just hearing.						
Moreover, Judge conduct throughout the proceedings was unsympathetic and discourteous. I have lost faith in the Arizona Civil Justice System due to the unfair treatment that I received at the hands of Judge and his staff. Judge has demonstrated a clear bias against me and discriminated against me before I even had a hearing scheduled. He gave the defendants two-and-a-half-month grace period of being in default and ignored my request for him to follow the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure. Instead, he scheduled a deadline for the defendants only around a medical procedure that he planned to take time off for which caused a further delay in seeking justice.						
To make matters worse, Judge and his staff juggled my case around other judges, often leading me to believe that I was scheduled to have a hearing when in reality, it was then scheduled for Judge once he returned from . This caused significant confusion and frustration on my part and further undermined my confidence in the judicial system.						
In summary, Judge conduct has been unacceptable and unbecoming of a judge. I urge the Arizona Commission on Judicial Conduct to investigate this matter thoroughly and take appropriate action to ensure that justice is served in my case and in all future cases before these judges. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
