ORDER

The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace was abusive in an eviction trial and ignored the evidence.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Barbara Brown and Christopher P. Staring did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

First of all, this case is in appeal and there was a Complaint filed with the Arizona Attorney General for Housing Discrimination before trial that is still active. I was unlawfully evicted from my apartment with a disability that meets the definition of disabled by the Americans with Disabilities Act. I had that information on file with the office. They just scheduled me to move out of my apartment on [] and when I got upset, they gave me a notice to vacate immediately on [] and [] lied about something throwing things. They had no right to schedule me to move out on the [] and they breached the agreement.

That being said, [] is the most abusive judge I've ever encountered. The case had a hearing and the defense was not prepared and instead of dismissing the case, [] offered them a continuance to go and find [], whom I think she has a personal relationship to based on her actions. The date of the trial, [] refused to let me speak. This was over a zoom recorded session and while I was speaking she was fumbling with papers and not paying attention. Then she literally stopped the trial to berate, belittle, and humiliate me for the "[]". I tried to tell her that I have an [] and that is just the way that I sound. She told me I was not allowed to sound the way I do. It was humiliating. I have []. I have trouble controlling the tone of my voice in extremely stressful situations where I'm being attacked. I had done absolutely nothing wrong and this judge would not let me speak and then yelled at me. Then, I tried to question the witness and she allowed the opposing attorney to belittle and make fun of me as well. I got [] to admit she screwed up and it was interrupted to further abuse me and my rights. They were fabricating some story that they had no witness, no evidence, no documentation of any sort and even [] said that story was nonsense.

I had a video that proved [] LIED in the court petition about me throwing things at her on [] WHICH IS STILL ONE DAY TOO LATE) and yelling vulgarities at her. I went to the office to find out why they scheduled me to move out without me being involved. When I arrived at the office she told me to get out and I put my lease paperwork showing the end of my lease on her desk and pulled out my camera. The judge didn't even watch the video. She told me that I don't have the right to speak to someone like that and BUT the only thing that was said on the video was "[]" because i was being harassed by the staff of this complex for months.

[] evicted me from my apartment IMMEDIATELY giving me [] hours to vacate as a person with [] for the sound of my voice over a zoom session. She said she evicted me for the video which was not a violation of the lease either. And the notice they gave me to vacate, that is required by law before you can start moving someone out, was given to me ON THE [] OF THE MONTH, NOT the [] so they literally violated my lease and then gave me a notice afterwards for my reaction to it, which is recorded. This was some kind of scam. But it is also a blatant violation of the 14th Amendment AND the Arizona Fair Housing Act.

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This is a former politician and she has no business throwing people out on the street that she has personal problems with or doesn't like the sound of their voices. I'm a business professional with a college degree and I'm also an Award-Winning Documentary Producer and this is not only an embarrassment, but I cannot find legitimate housing now because of this woman who appeared to just dislike me being a man or being alive in general. I would like to attend a formal hearing and take the stand against her and I want this video of the hearing to be shown as an example of blatant Discrimination against a disabled person.

Not only do I think that she might have some sort of personal or political donor relationship with _____, with _____ being such a small region, but I believe this Judge is abusing the constitution to help attorneys like _____ steal money form unsuspecting victims. My appeal has not had it's hearing yet but I have blatant proof in the form of an email from the office on _____ telling me " _____ " and my response was that I don't know what you're talking about. No one ever contacted me about moving out prior to the end of my lease. I was a part of some scam that _____ is involved in and I am asking that you investigate this for possible criminal intent.
