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**ORDER**

October 24, 2023

The Complainant alleged improper legal rulings by a superior court judge hearing a civil dispute.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission does not have jurisdiction to overturn, amend, or remand a judicial officer's legal rulings. The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission members Barbara Brown, Delia R. Neal, and Christopher P. Staring, did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

JURISDICTION

Under Arizona law, judges, county attorneys, and law enforcement officials are required to apply protective laws and court orders impartially and diligently. Judges have a legal duty to apply and ensure that valid protective orders are enforced, while law enforcement officers have an obligation to enforce these orders and other laws impartially and diligently. Public Officials have a shared responsibility to adhere to ethical standards and the law while carrying out their respective roles in the legal system.

Judge , and other Judges and Attorneys had probable cause to believe laws and protective orders were being violated and people were being

1 damaged by failures and refusal by the Office to enforce valid protective  
2 orders issued from the Court for and and their  
3 grandchildren.

4 Judge has not applied or enforced protective orders fairly or diligently in  
5 violation of A.R.S. 13-3602. His multiple failures or refusals to apply and enforce protective  
6 orders fairly and diligently resulted in the emotional and physical injury of people under valid  
7 protective orders. This complaint involved complaint retaliation and witness intimidation.

### 9 10 INTRODUCTION

11 and his family have been residents of , Arizona for over  
12 years. In of the family fell victim to a “  
13 ” during what was being called a real estate bubble in , Arizona. This  
14 swindle involved harassment, intimidation, threats and using strong arm tactics to gain access or  
15 acquire property non consensually.  
16

17 The police would not arrest, and prosecutors would not charge the attorney/land  
18 developer that assaulted wife in the driveway. The family was  
19 forced into Judge and legal spider web in  
20 Court ). This turned into a -year multimillion-dollar land swindle that put  
21 plaintiffs and some defendants into bankruptcy. The family was financially crippled and  
22 emotionally damaged for years.  
23

25 , was Judge " " ruling in . He  
26 signed the Final Ruling on . This was almost a year after the jury had come back  
27

1 with a verdict and Governor had appointed him as the first  
2 Judge of the Court on .  
3 Judge had assigned Judge to the case before he left  
4 the bench in . However, Judge was the prosecutor that refused to charge  
5 attorney with assaulting in the driveway on  
6  
7  
8 and Judge appeared to be associates and had been  
9 inducted into the on the same day of .  
10 asked Judge and to recuse themselves before  
11 Judge signed the Final Judgement on . Judge was  
12 furious and retaliated in his ruling.  
13  
14 years later, the same old players show up with the same old game. and  
15 the family have had many well documented experiences with these police,  
16 prosecutors, and judges over the past years. has closely watched the Arizona courts and  
17 retained a great deal of documented evidence to support his claims of aggravated harassment,  
18 discrimination, and other unethical and scandalous behavior.  
19  
20 The damage to and his family from these failures and refusals to apply ethics, obey  
21 and enforce rules and laws fairly and diligently are ongoing.

### **BACKGROUND**

25 , a man named ( ), was seen trespassing,  
26 tampering with survey stakes and boundary markers in the driveway in ,  
27 Arizona. and reported to the Office ( ).  
28

1 Deputy responded, investigated, and reported that did not own any property  
2 in , Arizona and he had been warned by property owners and his real estate agent  
3 about trespassing before . presented legal arguments to based on a  
4 misrepresentation of a Final Ruling signed by Judge on .  
5  
6 Deputy could have simply issued a citation for trespassing and disturbing  
7 the peace. Deputy is well known to from prior trespass litigation against  
8 in . Officials.  
9  
10 After Deputy conversation with , he seemed concerned. He advised  
11 and to set up security cameras, get protection orders from the court, and report any  
12 violations of law to . (IR # )  
13 , returned to the property and created an intimidating  
14 altercation with and and their neighbors, , and . He  
15 threatened that he had done his due diligence as if he were an attorney and threatened ,  
16 with violence and lawsuits if he did not get what he wanted. (video)  
17  
18 called and Deputy responded. offered a copy of  
19 a Final Judgement signed by Judge and a map of the property owner's  
20 easements. Deputy refused to accept the evidence and advised and to  
21 go to court to settle the matter. (IR # )  
22  
23 This happened to the family and neighbors once before in . An attorney/land  
24 developer, named , and others, used similar harassment, threats, and  
25 violence, that forced the family into with and Judge  
26 in of . This was an almost identical case with Judge  
27 of (from to ).

1 fraudulent legal arguments and threats of financial ruin and physical aggression  
2 on , created serious fear, and stress. demands and threats caused heavy  
3 chest pain and heart damage that led to extreme surgery for on . (Video and  
4 medical files)

5  
6 failure to enforce the law on , also forced and to get  
7 Protection Orders from , install and monitor security cameras, and pay to consult attorneys.  
8 , Judge issued Protection Orders against  
9 for , , and their minor grandchildren. and  
10 )  
11

12 did not stop his misrepresentations and threats, nor did he bother to request a  
13 hearing contesting the injunction orders. He continually insulted and insinuated he had friends  
14 and relatives that were Officials and bragged he could have arrested or  
15 financially ruined in at will. and continued reporting the threats and blatant  
16 violations of protective orders, per instruction.  
17

18 , threatened and she called , and Deputy  
19 responded. deputies stated they were ordered to no longer respond to calls for assistance  
20 after . provided the proof that was giving false information  
21 and legal advice to and misrepresenting Judge Final Judgement.  
22 (Video-14 minutes)

24 On , and came to the Clerk's Office to  
25 report violations of protection orders and a failure to enforce those orders by against  
26 that were issued on . Judge was assigned to hear
