The Complainant alleged a superior court judge violated her victim's rights.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Delia R. Neal did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Judge [redacted] several times put me in danger And did not take into consideration that [redacted] was on trial for stalking and several other crimes against myself. [redacted] broke into my house and [redacted] of [redacted] armed with an ax and TAZER, with the intent on committing bodily harm. Since this incident [redacted] has several times violated the restraining order against him. And the courts have done nothing about it [redacted] is still on trial for his crimes against me. Judge [redacted] has several times during the last two hearings relating to the divorce and I filed against [redacted] put me in extreme danger he several times suggested that [redacted] and I go into a closed room together all alone to discuss our options. [redacted] has stated several times to several different people that he will kill me when he gets the chance yet judge [redacted] did not respect my victims' rights and repeatedly to try to force myself into a situation that was not safe .

I several times voiced my concern for my safety and was not acknowledged by the judge.

After the last court hearing the judge instructed me to leave first which allowed [redacted] to watch my exit through the courts upstairs windows and see what vehicle I was driving [redacted] then proceeded to follow me almost all the way to where I was staying before I took evasive action.
