Rule 39. Notice of Violation; Form

Rule 42. Notice of Violation; Time for Delivery

A Notice of Violation is void if its delivery is not initiated in accordance with Rule 40 of these rules within ten days of the date of violation. ~~Delivery of a Notice of Violation must be initiated within ten days of the date of violation on the person charged in accordance with Rule 40 of these rules. If delivery is not initiated within ten days of the date of violation, the Notice of Violation is void.~~
