

**LOCAL RULES OF PRACTICE  
YAVAPAI COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT**

**Rule 10. Conciliation and Mediation**

**10.3. Arbitration**

All civil cases filed with the clerk of the Court in which the court finds or the parties agree that the amount in controversy does not exceed ~~\$25,000~~ \$65,000, except those specifically excluded by Rules 72 to ~~76-77~~, Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure, shall be submitted to and decided by an arbitrator or arbitrators in accordance with the provisions of A.R.S. § 12-133 and Rules 72 to ~~76-77~~, Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure.

An arbitrator assigned to serve in a case subject to the provisions of Rules 72 through 77, Ariz. R. Civ. P., shall receive as compensation for services in each case a fee not to exceed the amount allowed by A.R.S. § 12-133(G) per day for each day, or part thereof, necessarily expended in the hearing of the case.
