It appearing necessary for the administration of justice by this Court that the following retired judge is temporarily called back to active duty to serve on the Superior Court in Arizona.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 20 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the retired judge James E. McDougall is hereby appointed to serve as a judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, beginning upon entry of this order and ending September 18, 2000, or at the pleasure of the Arizona Supreme Court, for the sole purpose of entering an essential and final ruling in the case Cooke v Cooke, bearing Superior Court No. DR 97-13801.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Judge James E. McDougall shall receive no compensation other than that to which he is entitled pursuant to Article VI, Section 20 of the Arizona Constitution.
