Administrative order 99-8 requires all judicial employees to meet the continuing education requirements stated in that order subject to certain exemptions. Section K(2) exempts judges, law clerks and other court personnel holding temporary positions unless they are ordered to participate in educational programs by their respective chief judge or presiding judge.

It is advisable that supreme court law clerks who are active members of the State Bar receive continuing judicial education under the auspices of the Committee on Judicial Education and Training (COJET) rather than the State Bar Mandatory Continuing Legal Education program.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that supreme court law clerks shall be subject to Committee on Judicial Education and Training (COJET) requirements stated in Administrative Order 99-8 notwithstanding the Section K(2) exemption.
