On April 30, 1998, by Administrative Order 98-21, Judge Mark W. Armstrong, Presiding Domestic Relations Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County, was appointed to serve as a member of the Child Support Coordinating Council Subcommittee. Judge Mark Armstrong's recent rotation and promotion to Associate Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County has left a vacancy on this subcommittee.
