On August 20, 2001, by Administrative Order 2001-91, the Honorable Ronald Reinstein, a superior court judge member, was appointed to the Constable Ethics Committee with a term of service ending on August 1, 2003. Judge Reinstein has notified the Committee that he is unable to fulfill his commitment and has resigned from his appointment.

In accordance with Laws 2001, Chapter 4, the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court shall appoint one superior court judge, for an initial term of two years, and one justice of the peace, for an initial term of four years, to represent the judiciary on the Constable Ethics Committee. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Michael D. Jones, a superior court judge, be appointed to the Constable Ethics Committee to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of the Honorable Ronald Reinstein. Judge Michael D. Jones will serve the remainder of Judge Reinstein's term beginning upon entry of this Order and ending August 1, 2003.
