In accordance with Rule 33, Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, the Supreme Court is responsible for appointing members to the Supreme Court Committee on Examinations. The Court is advised that Michelle M. Allen is unable to fulfill her commitment to the Committee and has resigned. After consideration of the recommendations submitted by the Committee on Examinations,

IT IS ORDERED that the Court approves the appointment of David G. Bray, a present member of the Committee on Examinations, to complete the term of Michelle M. Allen which was to expire October 31, 2005. Mr. Bray was appointed January 31, 1999, to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of David Abney whose term was October 31, 1996 to October 31, 2003. Therefore, Mr. Bray's term of service on the Committee on Examinations is revised, upon entry of this Order, to January 31, 1999 to October 31, 2005.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Court approves the re-appointment of Eileen Dennis GilBride, a former member and Chair of the Committee on Examinations, to fill the vacancy created by the revision of Mr. Bray's term. Therefore, Ms. GilBride shall serve a term beginning upon entry of this Order and ending October 31, 2003.
