Administrative Order
No. 2001 30

Pursuant to Rule 82, Rules of the Supreme Court, the Chief Justice is responsible for appointing certain members of the Judicial Ethics Advisory Committee. Members of the Committee shall serve three-year terms; terms shall be staggered as designated by the Chief Justice; and no member shall serve for more than two consecutive terms. Members shall continue to serve until a successor is appointed, and appointments to fill a vacancy shall be for the balance of the terms.

Therefore, the Court is advised that the terms of the Honorable Stephen A. Gerst and the Honorable Jose Luis Castillo will expire on April 30, 2001. The Court is further advised that the Honorable Rebecca Berch and the Honorable Colin F. Campbell have resigned from the Committee leaving two vacancies to fill for the remainder of their term.


