It appearing necessary to the administration of justice in the Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, that the Honorable Rudolph J. Gerber, formerly a judge of that court and now retired, be authorized to participate in certain decisions of that court. Therefore, pursuant to Article VI, Section 20 of the Arizona Constitution,

IT IS ORDERED that the Honorable Rudolph J. Gerber, a retired judge of the Arizona Court of Appeals, Division One, is authorized to participate in the resolution of those cases in which he previously participated as a member of that court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the appointment is conditioned upon the agreement by the retired judge to serve for no compensation or benefit, fiscal or otherwise, other than that to which he is entitled pursuant to Article VI, Section 20 of the Arizona Constitution, including travel expenses when serving outside his county of residence.
