Pursuant to Rule I (4) of the Uniform Rules of Practice of the Superior Court of Arizona and Administrative Rule V-A III.B (4) of Administrative Order No. 93-30 (Revised), the presiding judge in each county shall appoint with the approval of the Supreme Court an associate presiding judge to act during the absence or unavailability of the presiding judge.

On July 16, 2001, by Administrative Order No. 2001-054 of the Superior Court in Maricopa County, the Honorable Colin Campbell, Presiding Judge, appointed the Honorable Thomas W. O'Toole and the Honorable M. Jean Hoag as Associate Presiding Judges.

Therefore, in accordance with the provisions of Uniform Rules of Practice and Administrative Rule V-A cited herein,

IT IS ORDERED that the Court approves the appointment of the Honorable Thomas W. O'Toole and the Honorable M. Jean Hoag as Associate Presiding Judges of the Superior Court in Maricopa County for a term beginning July 19, 2001 through August 13, 2001 and, in accordance with Rule I (7) (b), they shall serve in the absence of the presiding judge and associate presiding judge and exercise and discharge all powers and duties of the presiding judge, except that they may not appoint court commissioners or appoint judges permanently to special assignments.
