Pursuant to session law enacted during the 2001 legislative session, Chapter 4 (HB 2099), a Constable Ethics Committee was established to adopt a Constable Code of Conduct that hear, investigate, and resolve any complaints of inappropriate behavior of constables.

The Chairperson of the Arizona Commission on Judicial Conduct or the Chairperson's designee who is also a member of the Commission is the Chairperson of the Committee. The Chairperson of the Committee is a non-voting advisory member.

In accordance with Laws 2001, Chapter 4, the Chief Justice of the Arizona Supreme Court shall appoint one superior court judge, for an initial term of two years, and one justice of the peace, for an initial term of four years, to represent the judiciary on the Constable Ethics Committee.
