On December 16, 1998, by Administrative Order No. **98-78**, the Court adopted changes in annual membership fees for the State Bar of Arizona.

Upon review of the Order it has been noted by review of the fees recommended by the Board of Governors and the action of the court at the time that the membership fee stated for “members with less than 3 years experience” was in error. The annual membership fee for members with less than 3 years experience should have been as follows:

2. **Members with less than 3 years experience:**

Now, therefore, in accordance with the administrative authority vested in the Supreme Court by Rule 31(a) and Rule 31(c)6 of the Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, the Court has considered the annual for membership in the State Bar of Arizona; and

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 97-78 is amended to reflect the changes in membership fees as noted above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Order is effective nunc pro tunc as of December 16, 1998.
