The Supreme Court, having administrative supervision over all courts of the state pursuant to the Constitution of Arizona, Article VI, through its Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC), periodically conducts reviews and audits of court operations.

Whereas, an operational review of the El Mirage Municipal Court has been initiated and preliminary findings indicate that certain operational policies and case record keeping procedures must be changed to ensure the proper administration of justice and overall proper management of the court's case and financial records,

Whereas, effective today, the El Mirage Municipal Court is without a presiding judge. The assignment of the interim judge is necessary to assure the independent and proper operation of the court.

IT IS ORDERED that until further order of the Court, administrative supervision of the El Mirage Municipal Court shall be assumed by the Honorable Colin F. Campbell, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County until court operational problems identified during the AOC audit are corrected,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Presiding Judge Campbell may issue such orders, including assignment of an interim judge, as may be required to ensure the independent and proper operations of the El Mirage Municipal Court.
